THAT

Granite School District has complied with the provisions of the Worker's Compensation Act, Title §34A-2-101, Utah Code Annotated, 1997 (as amended), and the rules of the Labor Commission, and has insured the liability to pay the compensation and other benefits provided by said Act by insuring with Pinnacle Risk Management (Policy #: SI-849), PO Box 571647, Murray, Utah 84157-1647. WORKER'S COMPENSATION

IS INSURANCE THAT PROTECTS YOU DURING WORK. IF YOU HAVE AN ON-THE-JOB INJURY OR OCCUPATIONAL DISEASE, IT WILL PAY FOR: HOSPITAL AND MEDICAL BILLS * TIME LOST FROM WORK * PERMANENT LOSS OF BODY FUNCTION * PROSTHETIC DEVICES * BURIAL BENEFITS IN DEATH CASES.

HOW TO REPORT AN ACCIDENT

1. Report the injury – no matter how slight – to your boss immediately. (You may lose your rights if your injury is not reported promptly.)
2. **Call 288-4240 IMMEDIATELY** to report your injury the Worker's Compensation carrier, Pinnacle Risk Management.
3. You **MUST GO TO WORK CARE INDUSTRIAL CLINIC**, 2390 S. Redwood Road, for your first treatment. The only exception is for life threatening emergencies - go to the nearest hospital emergency room.
4. Tell the doctor **HOW, WHEN and WHERE** the accident happened. The doctor will fill out a medical report form. Copies of the report are to be sent within seven (7) days of your visit to (1) the insurance company, (2) the Labor Commission and (3) you, the employee.

HOW TO START COMPENSATION

1. When you call Pinnacle Risk Management to report your injury, Pinnacle will initiate your Worker's Compensation claim and will pay your medical bills and your time loss according to state law.
2. Work Care will send a medical report to Pinnacle and Pinnacle will pay Work Care for your medical treatment.
3. Call Pinnacle Risk Management at 801-288-4240 and ask them to start your Worker's Compensation benefits.

REHABILITATION

IF YOU CANNOT RETURN TO YOUR JOB, YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A REHABILITATION PROGRAM – CALL YOUR INSURANCE CARRIER AS LISTED ABOVE.

FRAUD

“For your protection, Utah law requires the following to appear on this form, any person who knowingly presents false or fraudulent underwriting information, files or causes to be filed a false or fraudulent claim for disability compensation or medical benefits, or submits a false or fraudulent report or billing for health care fees or other professional services is guilty of a crime and may be subject to fines and confinement in state prison.”
